- Covers math typically taught through 8th grade.
- Monthly local math contests followed by (Inter)² SECT national math championship.
- Season Opener: October 26, 2019

- Check-In 8 a.m., Contests Start at 8:30 a.m., and Awards* at 11:30 a.m.

High School Contests

- Students in grades 9 through 12, including 8th graders who are invited to compete with 9th graders.
- Covers math typically taught through 12th grade.
- Monthly local math contests followed by state and national math championships.
- Season Opener: October 19, 2019

Who We Are

Art of Doing Math is purely non-profit, volunteer run, and not driven by incessant adult-oriented fundraisers. We are focused on elementary, middle school, and high school math competition. Art of Doing Math is the official host of MathLeague contests in Northern Nevada. MathLeague (<http://mathleague.org/>) is the largest network of local, state, and national math competitions at the elementary, middle, and high school levels in the United States and abroad.

Contest Costs

- **Per student, \$20 each contest, in advance.**
- If competing in both elementary and middle school or in both middle school and high school contests, \$30 in advance for the pair.
- **Entire season of six contests is \$100 in advance, per student.**
- If competing in two, again, both elementary and middle school or in both middle school and high school contests, each month, then \$150 for the season.
